GENERAL MEETING MINUTES
November 13, 2012

Call to Order: President Scott Stromberg called the meeting to order at 6:32pm. Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer were present.

New Business:

Membership- 85% girls had joined the booster club, many through the Midwest gear ordering process. Boys teams were just finalized, so no final count was available. With these memberships, we should exceed the budgeted amount.

Corporate Sponsorship- Dedrah Barton and Deb McCaskey reported the advertising sales exceeded the budgeted amount with some pledge money which hasn't been collected.

Coupon Book Sales- David Goodwin has 700 books to distribute to the 8th-12th graders before Thanksgiving Break. Team parents will take them to the teams and coaches with some encouraging words. Each player is expected to sell 4 books for \$20 each or participate in the buyout and return 3 books, keep one and pay \$40. The coupon book sales are Nov. 19-Dec. 20. The Entertainment Company does penalize the booster club for any lost or unaccounted for books.

Mini Skills Camp- This elementary intramurals camp will take place December 15 at 6-10pm at the 9th Grade Center. Lori Nichols is chairing this fundraiser. High School players work the stations. Adults need to supervise and check-in elementary students.
