



Steve Dunlap Associate Director of Athletics

Steve Dunlap joined the Union Athletic Department as Assistant Athletic Director on June 1, 2002. He joined the athletic staff as an accomplished wrestling coach, having served as the head coach at Broken Arrow Public Schools from 1990-2001. Dunlap was named Union's Athletic Director in February 2007 and Associate Athletic Director and head varsity wrestling coach in 2008.

During his tenure at Broken Arrow, Dunlap led the Tigers to seven state championship titles, amassing an impressive 130-30 overall win-loss record and earning three national top five rankings and one other top ten ranking by *USA Today*. As the Union Head Wrestling Coach during the 2008-09 season, the Redskin Wrestling Team had a dual record of 18-1 and won the Class 6A State Championship. Beginning with the 2009 school year, Dunlap will serve only as the Associate Athletic Director.

Dunlap earned a Bachelor of Science degree in health and physical education from the University of Central Oklahoma and completed his Master of Education Administration degree at Northeastern State University in 2004. Before joining Broken Arrow schools, he taught and coached at Edmond Public Schools, where he served on the wrestling and football staffs.
